- Put together a new, quality backpack and fill it with the following supplies:

- Pens (1 pack)
- Pencils (1 pack)
- Pencil sharpener (1)
- Large eraser (1)
- Crayons (a 24-pack)
- Markers or colored pencils (an 8-pack)
- 12" ruler (1)
- Safety scissors (1)
- Folder with pockets (2)
- Wide-ruled spiral notebook (2)
- 1" 3-ring binder (1)
- School glue (1 bottle)
- "Scotch" tape or equivalent (1 roll)
- Glue sticks (1 pack)
- 8.5" x 11" Wide-ruled, loose-leaf paper (1 pack)
- Small toy (e.g. stickers, ball, marbles, jump-rope, yo-yo, jacks, car) (1)
